SUMMARY

The major areas of my work as National Deputy Chairperson since the last general meeting in November involved coalition and staff relations work. With the National Day of Strike and Action, the Social Security Review, and the federal budget, working with other groups and organizations was a key priority for the Federation. The staff relations work was frequent due to the many staff changes that have occurred in both the Ottawa and Toronto offices, including the high number of hirings. Other areas of work since November included international work, some media relations, and work around programmes.

The following are the highlights of my activities in each of the above areas, followed by a day to day summary. Full details of the Federation's work is contained in the National Executive Report to members.

Coalition work

As I mentioned, the Federation's coalition work has increased significantly over the past year. The National Deputy Chairperson has historically been the elected officer charged with overseeing this coalition work.

Most of my efforts have been working with our coalition partners within the Action Canada Network. The Network was instrumental in getting other groups and organizations to support and get involved in the Federation's National Day of Strike and Action. Through the ACN, we were able to solicit endorsements, financial support, material support, and other assistance across the country. In addition to meetings around the Day of Action, I attended several Steering Committee meetings, and the Network's General Assembly in March.

At one such Steering Committee meeting, it was decided to form an Executive Committee that would oversee the work of the Network in between Steering Committee meetings. A seven person committee was created comprising four from the social and community sector, and three from labour. I was nominated and elected to the committee, and have since attended a number of executive committee meetings.

In addition to the Action Canada Network, other coalition work that I have been involved in included meetings around the federal budget, the Alternative Budget, and such.

Staff Relations

There were a number of staffing issues which required a fair amount of time. In the Ottawa office, a number of hirings either took or are in the process of taking place. As the Staff Relations officer, I sit on all hiring committees, and therefore spent a significant amount of time in doing this. Other staffing duties occurred around the hiring of temporary staff such as the Strike Coordinator and General Meeting Coordinator. In the Toronto office, staffing changes in management required me to make the necessary arrangements. Finally, there were two weekend sessions for the collective agreement negotiations.

International work

My work around international issues centred mainly around communication with the International Union of Students. I remained in contact with Allison Lewis to receive regular updates on the situation with the Union. I was also in contact or was contacted by other national student unions, from, for example, Romania, Ireland, South Africa, Ukraine. Finally, I also helped with local 83's campaign to free Jorge Passalacqua, distributing the information and providing letters of support.

Media Relations

When necessary, I assisted with media work. A list of interviews is included in this report, and also under the summary of day to day activities.

Toronto office

Along with the Treasurer and Chairperson, I attended a number of meetings with David Jones. In May, I began working out of the Toronto office with Cass as acting co-executive director.

Travel CUTS

Since November, there has been one Travel CUTS Board meeting. I also attended a meeting with Rod Hurd and Patrick Crowley in Toronto as part of the Board's decision to develop a long-term strategy for the Company.
